### LOCAL TIPS

There are many things to do and to see in our beautiful Dubrovnik and its surroundings. If you are looking for suggestions aside from our tours, here are our recommendations:

Explore the beautiful Old town of Dubrovnik, an intricate network of cobblestone streets and squares filled with architectural treasures. Take a walk around city walls and marvel town's wonderful Renaissance, Gothic and Baroque churches, aristocratic palaces and red-roofed townhouses.

**Dubrovnik Card** is a unique pass that saves you money and allows entry into town's top attractions. Check it out at <https://dubrovnikcard.com/>. The Card can be purchased at front desk.

Even though Old town can be reached in 20 minutes on foot, if you do not fancy walking, here is a **timetable for local buses**: <https://www.libertasdubrovnik.hr/city-timetable/>. Bus tickets can be purchased at front desk.

**Lokrum island** is an ideal place for spending a tranquil day away from the hustle and bustle of Old town. This nature reserve can be reached in 15 minutes with a ferry from the port in Old town. It is famous for its serene atmosphere, botanical garden and 12<sup>th</sup> century Benedictine monastery. **Cable car** ride to mountain Srđ is a must if you want to enjoy the most beautiful view of Dubrovnik. To make most of this experience, it is our suggestion to take the cable car ride either early in the morning or late afternoon to avoid the crowds.
